"Solan District Leads Nation in Legal Guardianship Support for Specially Abled Children"

Ganpati Educational Society participated in the National Trust meeting chaired by the District Collector, Solan, Himachal Pradesh. As the Local Level Committee (LLC) NGO, a list of 11 people requiring Legal Guardianship support for the specially abled was presented. The committee approved

the list. The District Collector instructed the concerned Block Welfare Officers and DIET to support Ganpati Educational Society.

The Committee approved Ganpati Educational Society as the LLC NGO for the next three years, with the current period ending on June 6th, 2025. Awareness programs for Legal Guardianship of mentally challenged children will be organized at the Block Level by Ganpati Educational Society, which will also provide Block Resource Persons for this purpose. The Director of Ganpati Educational Society informed the committee that Solan District has achieved the



number 1 rank across Himachal Pradesh providing Legal Guardians to mentally challenged children.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to all participants.
